Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Annapolis Area Mark "X" or alternate mark if code flag "L" is displayed. **Competitors please check in with Race Committee boat prior to warning signal.** A yacht in the starting area other than at her authorized time can expect to be protested by the Race Committee.

Finish: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat (LEAVE RACE COMMITTEE BOAT TO PORT) and Choptank Area Mark "N" (R"2") off Tred Avon Yacht Club. Yachts finishing after sundown SHALL illuminate their sail numbers for at least 30 seconds at the finish line. If course is shortened, finish between orange flag on Race Committee boat and designated course rounding mark, either Bell G"7" (off Blackwalnut Point), or Mark "O" (Choptank River Light).

Course: Pass Thomas Point Light to starboard. Pass Bloody Point Light, buoy R"84" (off Poplar Island), and RN"80A" to port. Round buoy G "7" (off Blackwalnut Point) to port, pass Region 3 Choptank Area Mark "D" (R"10") to starboard and round Mark "O" (Choptank River Light) to port (29.2 nautical miles).

Radio: Race Committee will attempt to notify premature starters on VHF 71.

Time Limit: 9 hours.

Protests: Written protests must be delivered to Race Committee Chairman on Race Committee boat or representative at Club office within 1 hour of last boat finishing the race. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after completion of races.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7, 4th/15 or more finishers. Perpetual trophies will be given at Harleigh Presentation 1630 hrs, Sunday 10 August 2008. Others shipped UPS.

Social: Tender service provided. Cash bar, dock band, a la carte meals at club. Yachts may moor beside club piers at Dockmaster's discretion.

Other: Entry fee covers both Saturday and Sunday races. Fee is same whether competing in one or both races. Yachts must submit separate entry forms for each race. Bringing alcoholic beverages to and from the club premises is unlawful.
