

Private Lessons (all ages)

Prerequisites: none

Private Lessons provide an opportunity for one-on-one instruction to help develop or sharpen sailing skills, which could empower a new sailor with the confidence to advance to the next level or offer an experienced junior that needed edge on the course. Instruction follows the curriculum that best matches the sailor's interest level/ability and is determined by the sailor's time commitment. Hourly lessons are possible with any coach on staff. These lessons are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis, and are offered on Monday and Tuesday after regular instruction ends, from 3:30 - 6 pm. Given coach availability, additional lessons are possible between 1 - 3 pm on Monday - Thursday.
